Dues Are Due: Mail In Your Payment! All payments are due by January 30th 2025.

If we have not received your dues by this date your membership will be frozen. By February 1st, 2025 if payment is not received your membership will be terminated. If you want to be reinstated, you will have to reapply. If there are any issues about payment, please contact us to discuss this. (Please see Dues Chart on page 4)

The Annual meeting will be February 2, 2025. A separate email will be sent with the time, and the raffle items. There will be 2-3 firearms plus other items.

On a safety note: All firearms must be cased and uncased on the shooting point bench facing down range. Links are found in this news Any infraction can result in immediate termination of VOAGC membership.



Due to insurance requirements, All Members must take the Basic Range Safety Officer Class. This class has been ongoing for the last two years. Check the Training schedule for upcoming classes. We do not want to suspend memberships due to this requirement.

Guests; All guests are required to pay a ten (\$10) dollar fee. Exceptions are spouses and guest's under the age of 18. All guests must sign the waiver, they must sign in, and out of the range and <u>YOU</u> are <u>RESPONSIBLE</u> for this individual.

VOAGC Members

A few key points.

There are some changes to previous range practices. Please pay close attention to Points 4, 6 & 7.

- 1. Covid-19 Log Completion of the log will no longer be required.
- 2. All Shooting Lanes with the exception of Lane 1, may be used. If you are vaccinated or unvaccinated, masks are not required . Members should try not to take too long at a point if the range is getting crowded, courtesy. Members must bring their own PPE if they choose to wear it.
- 3. Guests are allowed but only one (1) per member. (ALL Guests REQUIRED to pay \$10 Fee)
- 4. All firearms must be cased and uncased on the shooting point bench facing down range. Any infraction can result in immediate termination of VOAGC membership.
- 5. With the new retrieval system, members are <u>NO LONGER</u> allowed down range to hang/use magnetic target holders. You may only go down range to police brass after a cease fire has been called. You are limited to standard targets, half silhouette targets only. (14×18)
- 6. 2025 dues are now being collected. All payments are due by January 30, 2025. If you have not paid by February 1, 2025, your membership will be terminated. If you would like to be reinstated, you will have to reapply. All members must provide a personal email. Work emails will no longer be accepted. If you do not provide us with a personal email, your FOB will be deactivated. All members are required to be members of the NRA. You must provide the VOAGC with an ID number and expiration date. If we do not receive this information, your FOB will be deactivated.
- 7. Due to insurance requirements, all members must take the Basic Range Safety Officer (RSO) class. If you have not taken the RSO Class, Key Fobs will be turned off. See the links under Upcoming Training to register for upcoming classes or visit voagunclub.com under Training and click on links there to register. The other NRA Safety classes, NYS CCW classes and Hunter Safety classes DO NOT Qualify as they are not approved by the insurance company.

We hope that you all stay safe and healthy and we hope that unrestricted use of the range will be norm for many years to come.

RANGE ISSUES





- I. Bulletin Board Cabinet: All posting of flyers in the range will be done by the board. If you would like something posted, you must submit it to the board. You can no longer post flyers where you want, they will be removed.
- 2. <u>Target Height</u>: The top of all targets must be **below** the yellow line on the range wall next to points I and 6. **NO EXCEPTIONS!!!**
- 3. Range Access: Guests are allowed but only one (1) per member. (Guests are required to pay a \$10 fee)
- **4. Range Access:** No current VOAGC member can allow a former member who was terminated for non-compliance with the safety class or dues payment into the range. If there is an incident, it will be cause for immediate termination of our insurance policy. That means the range will be closed for all. They may enter as a guest however, they must sign the guest waiver and pay the guest donation before they can use the range.
- 5. We are officially a CMP range
- 6. We are officially an NRA recruiting sight.

Attention all Gun Club Members

There have been recent safety issues in the range that need immediate attention.

NO ONE should be going DOWN RANGE

Thanks to the new retrieval system, no one should be hanging targets.

You may go down range to clean/sweep/police up brass etc. HOWEVER

Before going down range, all firearms should be inspected and be cleared of any ammo.

- * Firearms must be leveled off and pointed down range.
- * For Semi Autos, the magazine **must** be removed first and then cleared the chamber **must** remain open.
- * For revolvers the cylinder **must** be cleared and remain open.
- * Rifles will be cleared and chamber will remain open. Place the rifle at port arms (Muzzle facing up) and place the rifle on the rifle rack.
- * No one should be walking around with any firearm. All firearms should be handled at the shooting point when starting and finishing. Bring the pistol or rifle case to the shooting point.
- * Utilize chamber indicators. All firearms must have a chamber indicator. (Red or Orange flag).





Eligibility:



You are also eligible to join the Sons of The American Legion if you are the male descendant (stepsons and adopted sons included) of a veteran who died in service during World War I or since December 7, 1941, during the delimiting periods set forth in Article IV, Section 1, of the National Constitution of The American Legion or who died subsequent to their honorable discharge from such service, shall be eligible for membership in the Sons of The American Legion. There shall be no form or class of membership except an active membership.
